When do registrations open?

Why play with NBSF?

- The "Bin It to Win It" rule brings a thrilling twist to the NBSF competition! Special "top bins" targets are placed inside the goals, and if a player manages to land the ball in one of these targets, it counts as 2 goals instead of 1. This adds an extra layer of excitement and rewards skillful, accurate shots, making every goal even more impactful in the game!
- NBSF was created so that kids aged 6-14 could enjoy football in the off season.
- NBSF gives players the chance to continue to grow their technical ability and fitness whilst having fun.
- The competition is run on real turf grounds which provides continuity following the winter season with consistent playing conditions.
- NBSF provides a fun atmosphere, with the addition of food opportunities and gear sales.

Can we register a mixed/girls team?

- Yes mixed teams are allowed and more than welcome to register.
- **Girls Teams:** Girls have the option of playing in their own age group or one year below.

How many players do we need to register a team?

You will need a minimum of 8 players to register a team with a maximum of 10 players.

Can I wear sneakers to play?

Football boots are recommended for play. Moulded soles are fine however we
do not allow metal or screw in studs. Sneakers can be worn however they are
not recommended. Shin pads MUST be worn at all times during play.

How long does the competition run for?

- The competition runs for 11 weeks. 9 rounds plus one week of finals.
- There will be a one week contingency in case of weather.

How much does registration cost?

- Early bird registration cost is \$195 per player.
- If registering a team after the early bird period has ended the cost will be \$220 per player.

How long are the matches and what day do the games run?

- Matches are a total of 28 minutes per game. 14 minute halves with a 1 minute half time. Games will be run every half an hour.

Do your staff have WWCC?

 Yes, all staff and admin who work with NBSF and its players have to supply a current WWCC before approval.

What are the teamwear and kit requirements?

- NBSF will supply a team shirt for each player for a one off \$15 fee. Upon registration you will be required to add player sizings for these items. Each player is required to wear the team shirt supplied with black shorts and black socks.
- Goalkeepers will be required to wear a bib over their NBSF shirt. These will
 be supplied on match day and need to be collected from Admin. Please return
 the following match completion each week. Shin pads are compulsory.
